We also run weekly parent support group sessions with Mrs Stone (our Learning Mentor) any concerns could be shared at these sessions and intervention put in place.

We have more than enough staff outside, supervising the children (well within the ratio) who have received training. Unfortunately though accidents do happen. When they do the children receive First Aid (all staff are trained) and accident slips are completed and sent home.

I really feel glad that my child comes to this school and has such dedicated teachers who help her improve. She always leaves school with a smile on her face and loves coming in the morning.
